

COVID 19 DISASTER ASSISTING RELIEF PROGRAM

Help is available to eligible, local families impacted by the COVID 19 Pandemic.

The Guernsey County Department of Job & Family Services is accepting applications for their COVID 19 Disaster Relief Assistance Program. This program is intended to cover a short-term financial gap when a household's earned income temporarily stops, is reduced through no fault of the applicant, or requires assistance to ensure the household has the necessary supplies to remain safe during the short-term crisis. The maximum payment is \$500.00.

Guernsey County families must meet the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) financial and household criteria. For example, a family of four with a gross income of less than \$4,367 per month would be eligible. To see if your family qualifies, visit guernseycountyjfs.org for program guidelines or call 740-432-2381 to speak with call center representatives.

Applications are available on the Guernsey County Department of Job & Family Services website or at the agency. To expedite processing, you can submit a completed application via email or simply apply over the phone.

Qualified applicants must meet income guidelines and be financially responsible for a child.
